Description:	<p>Recess Coaching Services and Related Items:</p> <p><u>Recommendation</u></p> <p>The Administration through the Department of Schools is seeking Board approval of a partnership with Playworks Education Energized for the provision of recess coaching services in an amount not to exceed \$57,000.</p> <p><u>Summary</u></p> <p>The administration seeks to engage Playworks Education Energized to deliver an enrichment program that will support and provide training for high-functioning recess and movement opportunities during the school day both on the playground and in the classroom for the two EDGE campuses. The vendor is recommended as a result of an RFP.</p> <p>The goal of this plan is to ensure students receive strategies and tools for conflict resolution while incorporating multiple diverse and engaging play opportunities for all students during recess.</p> <p><u>Background</u></p> <p>The District has budgeted \$57,000 for the 2016-17 school year for this partnership which includes the following services to be performed at the two Edge campuses:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Multiple professional learning opportunities focused on conflict resolution, creating a safe and healthy environment, and play-based strategies throughout the school year • Daily in-person recess coaching during the school day • Weekly out of school physical activity opportunities • Data reports to show the success of the program • An end of year culture evaluation tool that assesses the impact of the program <p>The annual cost for each renewal option is \$57,000.</p>
