Description:	<p>Special Education Services and Related Items:</p> <p><u>Recommendation</u></p> <p>The Administration is seeking Board approval for the purchase of services in the areas of speech services, sign language interpreting, Independent Education Evaluations (IEE), initial evaluations and reevaluations, related services evaluations, Communication Access Realtime Translation (CART) services, language translation, supplemental direct Special Education services, and Licensed Specialist and School Psychology (LSSP) services in an amount not to exceed \$990,347, and authorization for the Superintendent to negotiate and execute the contract.</p> <p><u>Summary</u></p> <p>The District utilized the RFP process to identify authorized vendors for these services to ensure that all providers meet federal and state laws, rules, and regulations. Negotiation does not occur with a vendor until the need presents itself.</p> <p>For fiscal year 2016-17, the District spent approximately \$1,444,884 for these types of Special Education services. The projected total for the recommended vendors at this time is \$690,347 with a contingency of \$300,000 for additional services that may be required during the school year. The total cost for these services will not exceed \$990,347 and is included in the 2017-18 budget. The decrease in projected expenditures is due to the approval of additional positions for the 2017-18 school year.
